

# True Potential SEI Cautious

## Fund objective

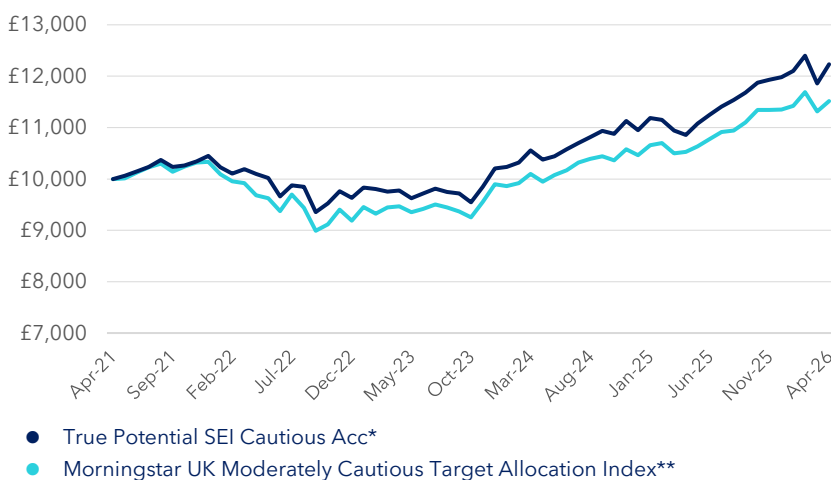
The Fund aims to provide growth and income by investing directly and indirectly in a selected range of investments in the UK and around the world, mainly in other investment funds which have a global equity and fixed income focus.

## April Update

Global equities rallied in April amid hopes of a ceasefire in the Middle East and solid corporate earnings. Emerging Market (EM) equities led the gains and outpaced their developed market counterparts. In developed markets, US shares outperformed, while UK equities proved a laggard. In fixed income, UK Gilts underperformed, while riskier high-yield (HY) bonds did well.

The True Potential SEI Cautious Fund returned 3.12% (net of fees). The Fund's allocation to equities drove performance as the asset class significantly outperformed over the month. All of the allocations to index funds that track global equity factors produced gains in absolute terms, but only the 'momentum' factor outpaced the broader market. The other factors lagged global equities, with a large allocation to the 'managed volatility' factor proving a laggard over the period, while the 'dynamic factor allocation', 'value' and 'quality' factors also notably underperformed. Elsewhere within the segment, the SEI Emerging Markets Equity Fund delivered the best gains overall. The Fund's allocation to fixed income produced mixed returns. The exposures to EM debt and HY bonds performed well, while UK Gilts declined in absolute terms. Elsewhere, the exposure to alternatives via the SEI Liquid Alternative Fund delivered modest gains.

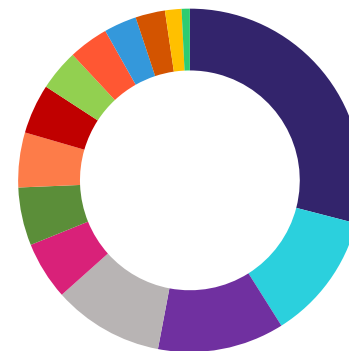
## What are the fees associated with investing in this fund?

The OCF of this fund is currently 0.96%. This means that if you invest £1000 in the fund, you can expect to pay £9.60 in fees over the course of a year. The fees you pay are pro-rata. If you hold the fund for less than a year you will only pay the proportional amount of fees applicable (based on the duration of your investment).

Risk type	Description
<b>Investment Fund Risk</b>	This Fund invests into other investment funds, they may invest in different assets, countries or economic sectors and therefore have different risk profiles not in line with those of this Fund.
<b>Performance Risk</b>	Investment objectives express an intended result but there is no guarantee that such a result will be achieved.
